

Warm-up: 7:45 - 8:45 am - Show Starts 9:00am

1. WARMUP- crossrails (UNJUDGED) Riders must present the paddock master with a TICKET obtained from the secretary in order to participate. Unstructured schooling session for a maximum period of 10 minutes.
2. LEADLINE EQUITATION - Riders 10 yrs. and under. Riders must have never entered any class other than leadline. May not enter another division at same show. Leader over 13 yrs.
3. LEADLINE HORSEMANSHIP - Same as above. May be asked an additional test.
4. PRE-BEGINNER'S EQUITATION - Entries individually ride at a walk and trot. Riders 12 yrs. and under. Pattern posted at show and issued by request prior to show, Same pattern all season. Riders to have never shown in any class requiring entries to ride collectively off of a lead line. May enter Beginner's over fences.
5. PRE-BEGINNER'S HORSEMANSHIP - Same as above, different pattern.
6. OPEN WALK-TROT EQUITATION - Open to riders of any age who have never shown in any class requiring a canter.
7. OPEN WALK-TROT HORSEMANSHIP - Same requirements as class #6. May require add'l test.
8. OPEN WALK-TROT PLEASURE - Same requirements as class #6.
9. INTRODUCTORY WALK-TROT EQUITATION - Open to riders of any age who have never shown in any class requiring entries to ride collectively at a walk and trot. May cross-enter with the Open Walk-Trot Division.
10. INTRODUCTORY WALK-TROT PLEASURE - Same requirements as class #9.
11. INTRODUCTORY WALK-TROT HORSEMANSHIP - Same as class #9. May require add'l test.
12. BEGINNER'S EQUITATION OVER FENCES - X-Rails not to exceed 12". Any age rider. May trot or canter course. May not enter any other jumping division. Riders to have never shown over fences higher than 12" at any show.
13. BEGINNER'S EQUITATION OVER FENCES (same as class #12)
14. SPECIAL EQUITATION - Riders of any age in their first year of showing at the canter in 2008.
15. SPECIAL HORSEMANSHIP - same as class #14, but judge may require additional test(s).
16. SPECIAL PLEASURE - same requirements as class #14.
17. UNJUDGED WARM-UP - 18" - same as class #1
18. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION - 18" - riders to have never shown over fences higher than 18" - No age limit. May trot or canter the course.
19. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION - 18" - same requirements as class# 18.
20. SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER - 18" - same requirements as class# 18.
21. SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER - 18" - same requirements as class # 18.
22. SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER UNDER SADDLE.
23. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION ON THE FLAT
24. OPEN PLEASURE - Divided if sufficient entries.
25. \$50 OPEN PLEASURE STAKE - Must have competed in class 24. Prize money: \$25, \$15, \$10
26. WARM-UP 2'0" (UNJUDGED) - same as class #1
27. LIMIT HUNTER 2'0" Horse/rider combination not to have competed over fences exceeding 2'3".
28. LIMIT HUNTER 2'0"
29. LIMIT HANDY HUNTER 2'0"
30. LIMIT EQUITATION OVER FENCES 2'0" Riders who have not won 6 firsts in equitation over fences exceeding 18", prior to December 1,2007.
31. LIMIT EQUITATION - FLAT -Open to riders who have not won 6 firsts in any equitation class above the Short Stirrup level prior to December 1,2007.
32. LIMIT HUNTER UNDER SADDLE
33. SPECIAL HUNTER 2'3" No restrictions on horse or rider.
34. SPECIAL HUNTER 2' 3"
35. SPECIAL HANDY HUNTER 2'3"
36. SPECIAL HUNTER UNDER SADDLE
37. OPEN HUNT SEAT EQUITATION - FLAT Divided if sufficient entries. No rider restrictions.
38. OPEN HUNT SEAT EQUITATION OVER FENCES 2'6" No rider restrictions.
39. LOW HUNTER - 2'6 - No restrictions on horse or rider
40. LOW HUNTER 2'6"
41. LOW HANDY HUNTER 2'6"
42. LOW HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

RULES AND CONDITIONS:

- 1) Exhibitors will be subject to the rules and conditions of the USEF unless otherwise listed on the entry form and this prize list. Anyone violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees, will not be permitted to show and may be asked to leave the grounds.
- 2) Be sure your entry form is properly completed and signed. Parent, guardian, or authorized agent, must sign for exhibitors under 18 yrs. Numbers will not be issued without the entry form being complete.
- 3) **NO LUNGING IN THE FIELD OR SHOW RING.** Our round paddock is available during Warm-Ups and lunch break for lunging your horse or pony.
- 4) Riding in the field will be restricted to the schooling area only. The flat area within the field, next to Lund Farm Way, is not to be used for parking, riding, or lunging.
- 5) All ribbons and prizes must be collected during the day of the show.
- 6) **PLEASE!! DO NOT BRING YOUR DOG TO THE HORSE SHOW!**
- 7) Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult responsible for the child.
- 8) The horse show reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes, and to substitute officials.
- 9) No refund for canceled entries will be given without a vet or doctor's certificate.

DRESS REQUIREMENTS:

Complete and proper attire is strongly encouraged, but not required.

Riding boots and helmets **are** required.

Half Chaps and Chaps may be penalized at the judge's discretion.

All hunt seat riders, and all riders under 18yrs, must wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets with chinstrap fastened whenever mounted.

FEES:

Entry fees: \$10.00 per class, \$15.00 stake class.

PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6:00pm the FRIDAY before the show. All other entries will be considered Post Entries. POST ENTRIES will be accepted but there will be a one-time post entry fee of \$10.00 added to the regular fees.

WESTERN RIDERS: The following divisions are open to Western and English:
Leadline - Pre-Beginner's - Open Walk-Trot - Introductory Walk-Trot - Special - Pleasure

CHAMPION & RESERVE awarded if three (3) or more entries in the division.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Beginner's Equitation over Fences
Short Stirrup Hunter - Special Equitation/Pleasure - Pleasure
Limit Hunter - Special Hunter - Low Hunter
