

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

WARM-UP - (1, 17, 28) Unjudged. **Riders must have a number and check-in with the paddock master to participate.** For safety, paddock master will restrict the number of horses permitted in the ring at one time. **For the cross-rail warm-up you must check in with the paddock master not later than 8:35am.**

LEADLINE (2, 3) - Open to riders 10 yrs. and under. Riders must have never entered any class other than leadline. May not enter another division at same show. Horsemanship class may involve an additional test at judge's discretion. Leader must be on foot and over 13 yrs.

PRE-BEGINNER'S (4, 5) - Entries ride **individually** at a walk and trot. Open to riders 12 yrs. and under. Pattern to be ridden is posted at the show and is always available from our website. The same pattern is used all season. Riders must have never shown in any class requiring entries to ride collectively off of a lead line. May enter Beginner's over fences.

OPEN WALK-TROT (6, 7, 8) - Open to riders of any age who have never shown in any class requiring a canter. Horsemanship class may involve an additional test at judge's discretion

INTRODUCTORY WALK-TROT (9, 10, 11) - Open to riders of any age who have never shown in any class requiring entries to ride collectively at a walk and trot prior to December 1, 2009. Horsemanship class may involve an additional test at judge's discretion. May cross-enter with the Open Walk-Trot Division.

BEGINNER'S EQUITATION OVER FENCES (12, 13) - 12" Cross-Rails. Any age rider. May trot or canter course. Riders must have never competed over fences higher than 12". May not enter other classes over fences except cross-rails warm-up.

SPECIAL EQUITATION, HORSEMANSHIP & PLEASURE (14, 15, 16) - For riders new to showing at the canter. Riders must have never shown at the canter in ANY competition prior to December 1, 2009. Horsemanship class may involve an additional test at judge's discretion. No age limit on rider.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION & HUNTER (18, 19, 24 / 20, 21, 23) - 18" - Riders to have never competed over fences higher than 18". **No age limit on rider.** May trot or canter the course.

MHJ SHORT STIRRUP MEDAL (22) - Open to **riders 12yrs of age and under.** Riders may not compete in any other equitation class at any show (except Short Stirrup) and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18" in height. The fences shall be cross-rails or verticals with no combinations.

LIMIT EQUITATION - FENCES (32) - Open to riders who have not won 6 firsts in equitation over fences exceeding 18" prior to December 1, 2009. Fences at 2'0".

LIMIT EQUITATION - FLAT (33) - Open to riders who have not won 6 firsts in ANY equitation class above the Short Stirrup level prior to December 1, 2009.

OPEN PLEASURE (25, 26, 27) - Open to horses and ponies with riders of any age. Entries in the stake class must compete in at least one other open pleasure class. Prize money in the stake class to be awarded: \$25, \$15, \$10. Trail class will consist of a pattern through, around, and over obstacles. Horses will be asked to walk, trot, & canter during the trail course. The trail class will be judges solely on obstacles - there will not be a collective flat session for the trail class.

LIMIT HUNTER (29, 30, 31, 34) - Restricted to horse/rider combinations who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3". Fences to be set at 2'0".

MHJ CHILDREN'S MEDAL (41) - Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of 12/1/09 and who have not shown over a course where the fences have exceeded 3'0". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional and must be adjusted according to fence heights. Only one horse/pony per rider. Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class. Fence heights: Sm/Med Ponies - 2'0", Lg Ponies/Horses - 2'6".

SPECIAL HUNTER (35, 36, 37, 38) -No horse or rider restrictions. Fences 2'3"

OPEN EQUITATION (42, 43) - No rider restrictions. Fences set at 2'6".

MHJ MINI-MEDAL (40) - Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of 12/1/09 with the exception of Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of 12/1/09. To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6".

MHJ ADULT MINI-MEDAL (39) - Open to amateur adult riders that have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 3' in the current year. To perform over a course of at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6".

LOW HUNTER (44, 45, 46, 47)- No restrictions on horse or rider. Fences 2'6".

MHJ JUNIOR MEDAL (48) - Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of 12/1/09. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'0". One or more tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion.

ALL MHJ MEDAL CLASSES - Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 8th. After August 8, 2010 only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class. RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Exhibitors will be subject to the rules and conditions of the USEF unless otherwise listed on the entry form and this prize list. Judges decisions are final. No exhibitor, trainer, parent, or spectator may approach the judge during the show day. Anyone violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees, will not be permitted to show and may be asked to leave the grounds.
2. Entry forms must be properly completed and signed. Parent, guardian, or authorized agent, must sign for exhibitors under 18 yrs. Numbers will not be issued without the entry form being complete. **All exhibitors must have a number to enter the ring - including Warm-Ups.**
3. **NO LUNGING IN THE FIELD OR SHOW RING.** Our round paddock is available during Warm-Ups for lunging your horse or pony. Thank you!
4. Riding in the field will be restricted to the schooling area only. The flat area within the field, next to Lund Farm Way, is not to be used for parking, riding, or lunging.
5. All ribbons and prizes must be collected during the day of the show.
6. **NO DOGS PLEASE!**
7. Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult responsible for the child.
8. The horse show reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes, and to substitute officials.
9. Any exhibitor who fails to settle an indebtedness with Woodsong Farm may be prohibited from participating in future Woodsong horse shows until the debt is settled.

DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Complete and proper show attire is required for all classes. ALL riders must wear an ASTM certified helmet when jumping.

ENTRY FEES & CLOSING DATES

ENTRY FEES: \$10.00 per regular class | \$15.00 per stake or medal class

PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6:00pm the FRIDAY before the show. All entries received after 6:00pm Friday will be considered Post Entries. Entries will be accepted after Friday, but there will be a one-time post entry fee of \$10.00 added to the regular fees. There is no fee for scratched classes.

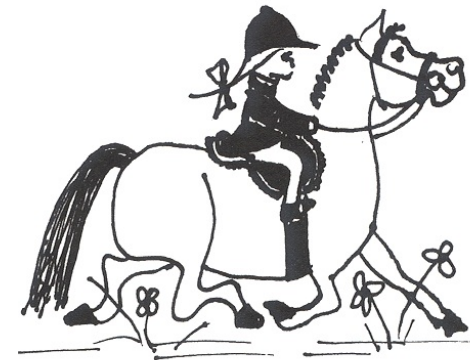
This year we are excited to include MHJ Medals in our schedule!
